## WHY PROGRAM ON SUSTAINABLE MANUFACTURING?

Blend of Ecology and Economy + Resilience

- Resilience = the ability to recover from or adapt to an unexpected change (e.g. realized risk)
  - needs to be systematically designed, planned and built <u>in advance</u>
- Short term action plan: diversification
  - Supply and demand management
  - · Customer and partnership management
- Long term action plan: **strategic** development
  - Strategy and scenario rework
  - Governance practices
  - Procedures
  - People management

#### Research, Development and Innovation


