1) Microloans vs. bank loans

Both forms

- Cover needs from 5.000 euros to millions
- Can be short-term (e.g. bullet loans) and long-term
- Require passing some form of auditing process ("sanity check") and focus on your cashflow ("payback capability")
- Almost always require personal guarantees

Pooled microloans

- Typically have much higher interest rates than bank loans.
- Are mostly taken by SMEs for growth when further debt leverage is needed than a traditional bank can offer.

Traditional commercial banks and Finnvera

 Are often the best fit for any new business for debt without business history and records (high risks) by using personal guarantees and relationships.

Lisäksi yhtiöllä on käynnissä Business Finlandin tuotekehitysprojekti, josta sille on myönnetty 238.000 euroa rahoitusta seuraavan

vuoden aikana. Yhtiön pääomarakenne on hyvällä tasolla, sillä yritys on juuri

saanut 138.000 euron sijoituksen uuden osakkaan myötä.






2) Equity crowdfunding

Crowd = "Mini angels"

- Invest own assets
- Personal interests
- Typically 500€ 5k€/case

Platform crowdfunding rounds

- Range from 100k€ to 3M€
- 5-25 % ownership
- Mostly direct (no vehicle formed)
- SHA with limiting rights



2) Crowdfunding vs. Angels

- Both ask for
 - Ability to sell you vision and growth potential
 - Initial "ready" group of investors
 - Some loss of control and decision making power
- Equity crowdfunding
 - Rounds and valuations tend to be higher
 - Good fit for building a fan base
 - Some cost for using platform and for marketing
- Business Angels
 - Try to offer "smart money"
 - Might more easily participate on next rounds
 - Requires notable time to find the right investors

3a) Pre-sales = customer money

- Selling your product online on a platform
 - Sort of "e-commerce" connected with a strong emotional feeling and a credible story
 - Best fit for physical consumer products (gadgets) with a price of 20...200 euros
- Requires heavy marketing due to high number of campaigns on the platforms
 - Nice video and nice looking photos
 - Ability to reach intended audience somehow
- Sales income for Finnish tax authorities
 - Thus VAT needs to be paid from collected money



Dear Backers,

We are sad to inform you, that we are unable to fulfill the orders of our campaign "SpineGym – Strong Back and Abs for Life".

As you already know, the campaign was conducted back in 2016. Since then we have provided numerous updates on the progress of the project and as we explained in our updates, the road has been full of many surprises, obstacles, and drawbacks along the way.

We have worked extremely hard to pull the project to a successful conclusion, but despite the persistence and the optimistic attitude that has characterized this endeavor, we now find ourselves at a stage where we have to admit that there is no possibility to go further.

All the capital, including the funds from the crowdfunding campaign and our own personal savings have been exhausted.

You are likely to wonder what the money has been spent on over the last 4 years.

Well firstly we want to clarify, that when a crowdfunding program ends, only part of the campaign backing comes to the campaigner.


So for Spine Gym we can see below how the funds have been spent

5%	Campaign platform commission (Kickstarter or IndieGoGo)
5%	The credit card company for their fixed percentages on the turnover.
30%	Funded Today, marketing agency that advertised and ran our campaign
4%	Another agency preparing the campaign material
2%	Campaign registrar (Finnish companies can't register directly into Kickstarter).
2%	Survey producer & logistic partner
3%	Royalty payment to the original inventor

After all this, less than 50% of the campaign funding was remaining for us to organize everything and cover all the costs that ensued.

3b) Perks & donations

- Finnish legislation forbids open collection of donations for a business
- Despite this, you can sell perks for fans like t-shirts, mugs, VIP memberships etc. as long as there is pricing (not "pay what you want")
- Some have chosen to operate an association (ry) or a foundation (sr) and a business in parallel (Oy) to have more flexibility
 - Integrify ry and Integrify Oy
 - Kompensäätiö sr ja Compensate non-profit operations Oy

Summary of Crowdfunding for SMEs

Forms:

Pooled microloans (= debt):

pooling of small private loans, often w/o collaterals, but using personal guarantee

Examples of web services:

Fundu.fi, Vauraus.fi, Invesdor

Perks (= "grants"):

sell "invaluables" like t-shirts

Mesenaatti.me, via social media or directly to fans

Equity investments:

collect a big group of "mini business angels"

Invesdor, FundedByMe,
Privanet/Around, Innovestor and
others

Pre-order:


sell consumer products (to raise funding for 1st batch)
