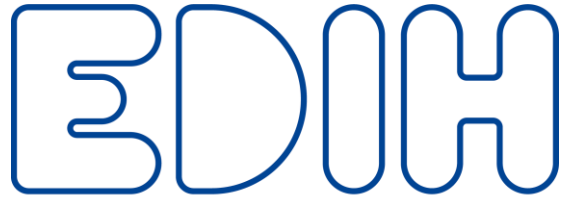

## Summary of the service

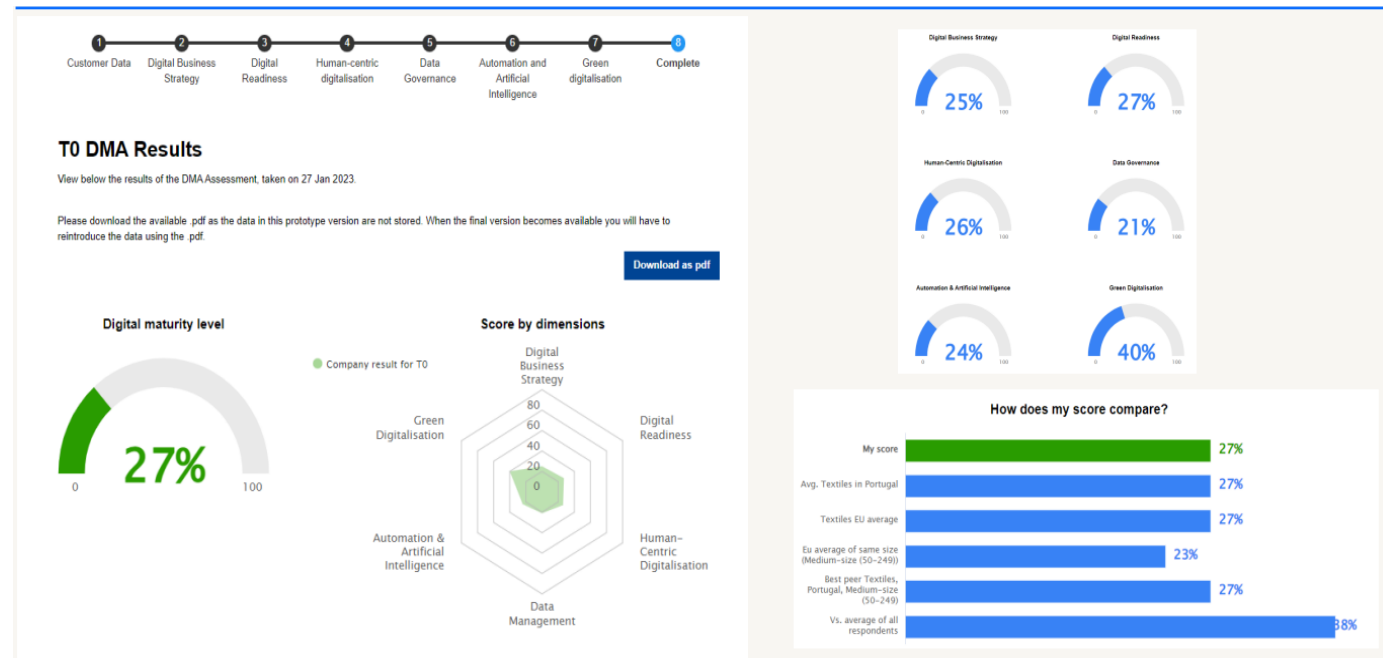

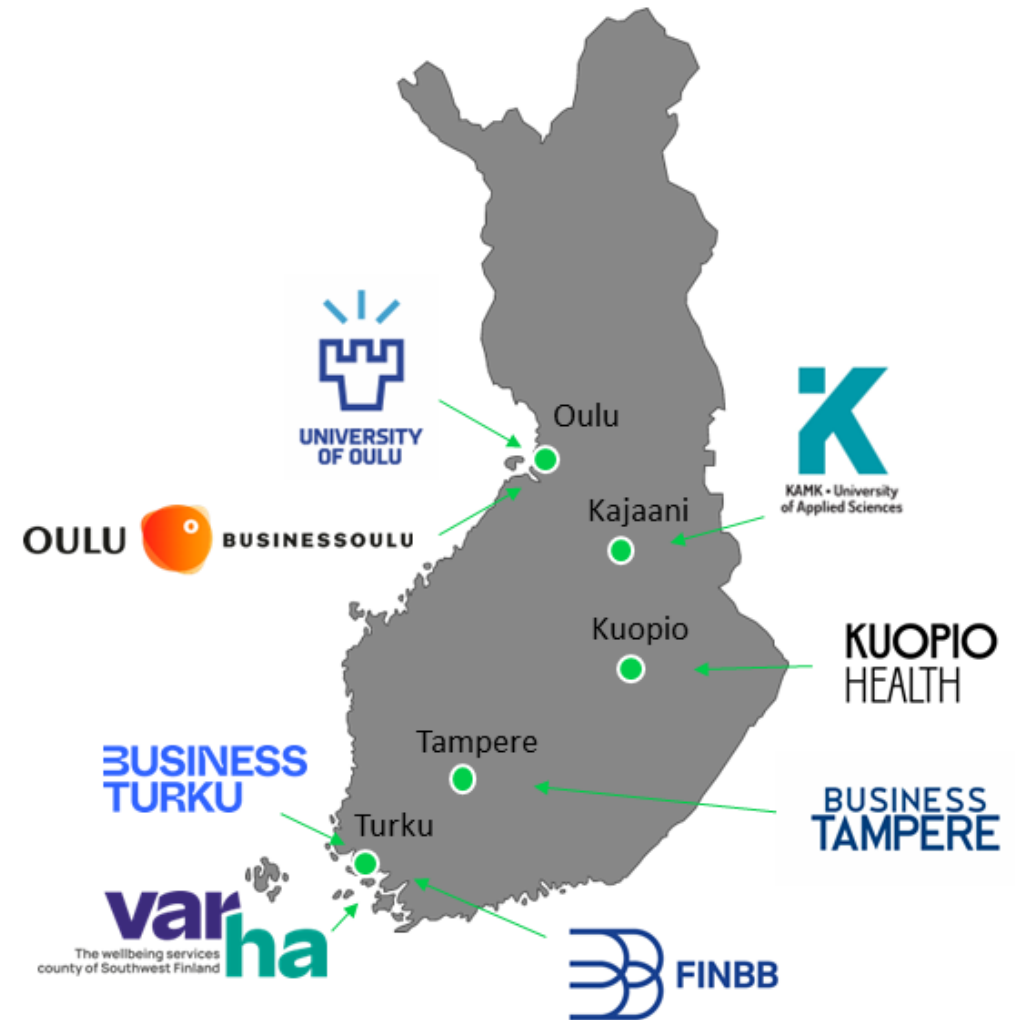
